Membership

Membership in this Chapter shall be in the following classifications:

A. Active

Active membership in APLA shall be available to land professionals primarily engaged in land work relating to the oil, gas and mineral industry and other persons primarily engaged in professions closely related to land work in the oil, gas and mineral industry. As used herein, the term "land work" includes, without limitation, the acquisition or divestiture of mineral rights, and/or the negotiation of agreements providing for the exploration and development of minerals.

B. Honorary

Honorary membership shall be available to the following:

1. Persons who are at least sixty (60) years old who have been an Active member of this association or another association affiliated with the AAPL for five (5) consecutive years immediately preceding such application and who are fully retired from land work.
2. Persons who, in the opinion of the Executive Committee, have rendered outstanding service or contribution to the oil, gas and mineral industry or to this association.

Honorary members shall be exempt from paying annual dues.

All Active and Honorary members of APLA shall be entitled to vote, hold office, serve as committee chairpersons and enjoy the full privileges and responsibilities of membership. All Active and Honorary members of APLA shall agree to abide by the Code of Ethics and Standards of Practice promulgated by the AAPL.

C. Associate

1. Associate membership in APLA shall be available to persons, who, although not actively involved on a regular basis in the oil, gas and mineral industry, have an interest in the progress and current status of the oil, gas and mineral industry in the region serviced by APLA.
2. Associate members shall be entitled to enjoy all benefits of membership in APLA; however, Associate members shall not be entitled to vote in any election of officers or other issues of APLA, nor shall they be entitled to hold office in APLA.

Effective March 2007, application for membership in this association under any category shall require signed recommendations by at least two (2) active members and approval by the Executive Committee. Any question regarding membership classification shall be finally determined by the Executive Committee.

Revocation of membership shall be approved by a majority vote of the members present at any regularly scheduled meeting. Revocation shall be used only in extreme circumstances in which a member's conduct exhibits an attitude contrary to the best interest of APLA and the land profession in general.
